


## Sanctuary Headquarters

- 30 staff, 3 buildings in Presidio






# Historic Coast Guard Lifesaving Station (1890-1992)





- Nov 2006 Complete Facilities Master Plan (Rehabilitate and occupy campus)
- Apr 2008 Complete Cultural Landscape & Historic Structures Reports
- Aug 2008 Sign long-term Occupancy Permit with Park Service
- Nov 2010 Complete Rehabilitation / Open Ocean Climate Center
- Nov 2012 Complete Lead Abatement / Paint Campus
- Jul 2013 Complete 65% Design for Lifeboat Station
- Dec 2013 Complete 100% Design for Shop/Garage
- Mar 2014 Complete 65% Design for Exhibits and Landscape
- Feb 2016 Complete Utilities Upgrade
- Jan 2018 Complete HVAC repairs, begin pier repair NEPA & window repairs








### **Current Priorities**


