The Greater Farallones National Marine Sanctuary has expanded to include the rich ocean waters off the Sonoma/Mendocino coast. Join us in a conversation with Maria Brown, Sanctuary Superintendent, and visually explore the bounty of the sanctuary, learn about sanctuary's programs in and around The Sea Ranch, and share our vision for the sanctuary at our doorstep.

Under Maria's leadership the sanctuary is working with local communities to respond to climate change; restore critical estuarine habitats, seabird colony roosting and breeding sites, and rocky intertidal habitats; conserve white sharks; strengthen emergency response preparedness; and design a new sanctuary campus to highlight green facilities and inspire ocean conservation. Maria is a San Francisco Bay Area native who grew up exploring the coast and enjoys sharing her love of the ocean with her husband and two boys.
