



Fisheries

Overfishing of anchovy

Anchovies filled with domoic acid – not fit for consumption

Anchovies are needed for whales and other marine mammals

Overfishing (in general) is a problem

Fishermen view MBNMS in negative manner/feel alienated

*New Action Plan Needed?

Artificial reef

Dive community requests an artificial reef (boat, plane, other)

Artificial reef would contribute to local economy

Reefs would serve as seed sights (production) for surrounding area

*Action Plan Revisions Needed?





Mooring buoys

Dive community requests moorings at popular dive sites Preserves benthic habitat/Less disturbance to wildlife Better dive safety (no slipped anchors)

*New Action Plan Needed?

Motorized Personal Watercraft MPWC)/Jet-ski

Allow for MPWC use as a safety tool, and for increased recreational opportunity.

Allow for MPWC use at other high surf locations

Expand recreational opportunities of MPWC to other locations to

allow for practice of rescue methods

Legal use of MPWCs at Mavericks is unrealistic

*Minor Action Plan Revisions Needed





Coastal armoring

Concerns about climate-related sea level rise, increased erosion, shoreline loss

*Action Plan Revisions Needed

Beach Nourishment/Harbor dredge disposal

Concerns about severe erosion at Surfer's Beach (Half Moon Bay) Amend sanctuary regulations/designation document to allow for the dredge and disposal of clean, compatible sediments
