Review of Marin/Sonoma Coastal Regional Sediment Management Report

Doug George, GFNMS staff, received a comment from Jack Liebster adding in a line regarding

Bolinas Lagoon under "Oversaturated Locations": Bolinas Lagoon opportunities may exist to

have multiple benefits to the ecosystem and recreational benefits through redirection of

accumulated sediments.
