Directions to The Marine Mammal Center

Driving Directions from North of the Golden Gate Bridge:

Take the last Sausalito exit off Highway 101, just before the Golden Gate Bridge. At the exit stop sign, turn right and go under the freeway, then follow the road down to the left.

Within 300 feet you'll see a left turn sign pointing to the Marin Headlands (this is the only available left turn before you begin the descent into Sausalito). You should see a tunnel with a five-minute light. Proceed through the tunnel.

Continue following the road (Bunker Road) for approximately 2.5 miles until you see Rodeo Lagoon on your left. Follow the road with the lagoon on your left until you reach a stop sign and the road forks.

Turn right at the fork, continuing uphill. Turn right at your next opportunity, which features a sign for The Marine Mammal Center. Head up the hill toward the hospital and parking lot.

Driving Directions from South of the Golden Gate Bridge:

Just after you cross the Golden Gate Bridge, take the second exit off Highway 101 at Alexander Avenue (after the Vista Point). Within 100 feet, you should see a left turn with a sign for the Marin Headlands (this is the only available left turn before you begin the descent into Sausalito). You should see a tunnel with a five-minute light. Proceed through the tunnel.

Continue following the road (Bunker Road) for approximately 2.5 miles until you see Rodeo Lagoon on your left. Follow the road with the lagoon on your left until you reach a stop sign and the road forks.

Turn right at the fork, continuing uphill. Turn right at your next opportunity, which features a sign for The Marine Mammal Center. Head up the hill toward the hospital and parking lot.

Parking:

The Center has a large parking lot located to the right as you approach the facility gate. An additional small parking lot that includes placard parking spaces is available directly in front of the Center at the top of the hill.
