Take Highway 80 W and merge onto US 101 and take the Fremont St exit and turn left onto Pine St then left onto Franklin St. Follow US 101 N. Use the left two lanes to turn left onto Lombard St and continue onto Richardson Ave. Continue onto US 101/Presidio Pkwy then take the exit for CA-1 toward Mill Valley/Stinson Beach, turn left to continue on to CA-1 and the parking will be on your right as depicted in the image below; there is no parking near the meeting space.
